

The ANS/Ambu® Clinical Physiologist and Student Award

Ambu® are working alongside ANS to award a prize for:

Physiologist of the year and **Student physiologist of the year**

This award is in the form of a £1,000 prize to encourage any grade of physiologist who has '**gone the extra mile**' at work. This can take any form, for example, improving patient satisfaction; improving patient/public participation; outreach and engaging with the potential future workforce (e.g. school/college/university healthcare science awareness days). Maybe they have set up a new service or a new way of delivering a service (e.g. one stop shop, home video-telemetry) or provided an outstanding teaching environment for the future workforce. £500 of the prize monies must be used for education purposes in the winner's department and Ambu® will provide a £500 voucher (of the winners choice) to the winner for the remaining £500.

The award is open to all ANS members and the nomination process will open in January (via ANS Newsletter) The successful applicant/s will be announced at the September meeting with a summary account to be submitted to JANS to share with the wider membership.

All applications will be passed to Sarah King at Ambu® where upon they will be anonymised and passed to ANS for judgement.

Supporting Statement Guidance:

Support the statement with specific examples that address the award you are nominating for and elaborate on why the nominee's accomplishments are worthy of the award. These examples should include outcomes, results, and/or activities above and beyond the nominee's job description. Include qualities that make this person's activity outstanding, and that are clearly relevant to the award criteria (e.g., contribution, team-building, collaboration, initiative and leadership). Consider including the following evidence to answer the 'who, what, when, where, why' in your supporting statements:

✧ WHAT did the nominee do (e.g., projects, activities, inspirational leadership)

- Projects and/or activities above and beyond the nominee's job description
- Any challenges or issues encountered and overcome
- They influence without authority, often putting the interests of others ahead of their own, and serve as "a champion for staff."

✧ HOW did they do it?

- Initiative and/or leadership (fosters an atmosphere of collaboration and creativity)
- Teamwork
- Creativity and/or innovation
- Behaviours and/or attitudes
- Collaboration/mentoring/coaching
- Going green/contribute to a culture of sustainability.


✧ WHAT were the results and/or impact?

- What did the nominee's efforts accomplish?
- Are there specific benefits to the patient/family/service
- Achieved desired outcome despite adversity (e.g. limited resources, time constraints, unexpected challenges).

For any nomination that does not meet the award criteria the awards committee may reject the submission or ask for a resubmission of the nomination. Once requested, the nominator may have two weeks to resubmit or the nomination will be rejected.

All ANS members or patients/the public are invited to nominate for the Ambu® award using the Ambu® nomination form.
